## Website Design Requirements

Identify the <b>PURPOSE AND NEED</b> for your website
Information on TARGET AUDIENCE: age, occupation, sex, residence, computer literacy of the target
Create <b>CONTENT</b> that is relevant to the website purpose
COPYRIGHT RULES must be adhered to, and citations must be used where appropriate
Understand that <b>PAGE ELEMENTS</b> are affected by user download speed, screen resolution, operating system, browser type and device
Maintain <b>CONSISTENCY</b> in page layouts, use of graphic elements
Use visual HIERARCHY
Define and show how you have used <b>USABILITY</b> (Note for teacher: elements such as labeling of links, page loading time/file size, ease of finding desired information, consistent/global navigation, consistent location of repeatable items, site maps, alternative text, use of text size and color, buttons, rollover links, use of tables for complex data, above the fold or scrolling, visual hierarchy)
Define and show how you have used <b>READABILITY</b> : (Note for teacher: minimum font sizes, when to use serif/san serif fonts, use of font color, alignment, indentation, headings, paragraphs, use of ordered and unordered lists)
Develop a form and gather <b>FEEDBACK</b> during the test phase
Demonstrate knowledge of how to create and build pages from <b>TEMPLATES</b>
Demonstrate knowledge of how to create LINKS to external information
Demonstrate knowledge of how to add <b>VIDEO</b> to a web page
Demonstrate knowledge of how to use <b>STYLES</b> in a Muse web page
Identify image file types that can be viewed in all browsers. (Note for teacher: file types such as jpg,
gif – NOT doc, tiff, eps, pdf, aif, bmp, png, etc.)
Demonstrate knowledge of how to LINK TEXT OR IMAGES TO AN EMAIL ADDRESS.
Insert NAVIGATION BARS and BUTTONS
Demonstrate knowledge of IMAGE FILE TYPES and their uses: file types such as GIFs or PNGs for
transparent background and large areas of solid color; JPEGs for photos and images with a
large tonal range, PNGs or JPEGs when targeting mobile devices
Demonstrate knowledge of how to create and import <b>PHOTOS</b> and <b>GRAPHICS</b> .
Demonstrate knowledge of how to publish files to a <b>REMOTE SERVER</b> .
